COURSE DESCRIPTION:


The EMT Online Hybrid course adheres to the US Department of Transportation EMT National Curriculum. This training program is approximately 195.5 hours in length, including both the online, clinical and hands-on training requirements.

Graduates of this program will be able to describe the essential elements for response to the scene of a medical emergency; perform a thorough patient

assessment for signs and symptoms of illness/injury; provide prompt and efficient basic emergency care to the sick and injured.

Students will also learn how to safely handle and prepare the patient for transporation and describe the essential elements of safe and orderly transportation of the patient to the hospital and transfer of the patient to a higher level of care.
